Curricula and learning materials will be analysed, relevance of textbooks and teaching methods will be assessed in the partner countries, involving stakeholders. A comparative study will be created with the conclusions and recommendations.

Indicators

The aim of these working phase is to elaborate the resources (curriculum, e-learning environment, learning content and methodology) of the blended course for VET teachers in order to prepare them for applying a new model of teaching integrating labour market-oriented content development and project-based methods in a collaboration with other teachers, students and companies.





Project-based teaching and learning is a priority in VET education, still as our preliminary needs analysis shows, many teachers do not apply this method confidently and regularly. Most of them are aware of the importance of PBL, and have some knowledge about its features but they need practical guidance on how to apply the method, step-by-step, with a lot of examples.

In VET there are many teachers, trainers who have less experience in pedagogy, they will need this kind of instruction surely.

The target group is VET teachers.

An online learning environment will be designed in Moodle in 4 languages (EN, IT, DE, HU).

4 online modules will be implemented: 1. Project-based learning, 2. Digital Tools for VET project management, 3. Innovative assessment practices for VET, 4. Creation and innovative use of digital content for VET) which will be followed by a practical session in project management.

One of the innovative features of the results will be the curriculum aligned with the educational frameworks of the EU, such as European Qualification Framework (EQF or its national adaptation like MKKR in Hungary) and Digital Competence Framework of Educators (DigCompEdu), and applying the EQAVET Quality Assurance recommendations even in designing the curriculum.

The innovative side of the applied blended methodology is that we are going to deliver a practical session after the online part of the training, where we are going to simulate a project. The teachers will take active part in delivering the project results. They will have to work as a project team, using methods and digital tools they got familiar with in the online training. This way they will experience what they will have to do later with their own students.

It means that the blended course will be delivered by applying the methodologies suggested by the Digital Education Action Plan 2021-2027:

- learning-by-doing;
- active learning;
- focused on the methods of digital education.

Another innovative aspect of the training is that a separate module will be dedicated to innovative assessment practices. There is an increased need for instructions, good practices in this field, as online education requires a completely new approach to assessment - many teachers experienced that traditional ways (tests, quizzes) do not always work effectively.

Besides giving grades, new types of assessment have to be implemented in the daily practice of teachers. For example, observation sheets, self-assessment questionnaires, checklists assessing presentation, collaboration etc. Assessment has to focus on soft skills as well, not only on detecting the mastered knowledge. It has to serve as a tool for identifying further development opportunities for the learners. It has to give also feedback to the teacher on where he/she has to develop his/her own teaching process to get improve learning outcomes.

Although our project focuses on initial VET training of 2 sectors, this training programme will be applicable in VET education in general as PBL, digital content creation are topics relevant to all sectors and levels.

Innovative assessment practices will be applicable even outside VET, so the result have the potential of usability in a wide

Key performance indicators:

- Curriculum of the PBL-based upskilling course for teachers at least in 10 pages in four languages (EN, DE, HU, IT)
- Digital learning content in 4 modules in 4 languages, in an estimated size of 20 pages per module.
- At least 5 teachers completing the training successfully in Italy, and another 5 in Germany. Min. 15 teachers completing the training successfully in Hungary.
- Successful completion means above 75% overall performance in the online part of the course, plus mandatory participation at the practical session.
- Evaluation of teacher training by participants: min. 80% overall satisfaction
- Accreditation of the training programme in Hungary in the teachers further training system.

Activities:





- R2-A1: Curriculum and course design for blended learning

The curriculum design, the implementation of the e-learning platform and the content development will be led by iTStudy because they have many years experience in applying EU standards (like EQF, DigComp, EQAVET, in implementing e-learning platforms and in development of digital learning contents. However, all partners will be strongly involved into all activities because the final results have to be harmonized with the special needs of the partner countries as identified in R1.

R2-A1: Curriculum and course design for blended learning

For all modules the expected learning outcomes will be defined, and we will refer to the relevant DigCompEdu competencies to show which competences of the participant teachers will the training develop.

R2-A2: Content development and review (EN, HU, DE, IT)

The learning content will be developed in collaboration of all partners, with iTStudy's leadership. For each module a closing assignment will be created which will be graded.

Forum will be operated within the learning environment to ensure knowledge sharing among participants.

First the English version of the content will be prepared, evaluated and finalized.

Once it is accepted by all partners, translation and localization to Italian, German and Hungarian will follow.

R2-A3: Implementation and testing of the online learning environment

The multilingual online learning environment will be based on the open source Moodle framework, what will be customised to the planned active learning methodology by implementing a selection of digital course components, for example videos, forum, e-books, graded assignments, etc. aligned with the project's branding guidelines in each language version as well.

The implementation to the learning environment will start with the approved English version, and it will be followed by the other versions once they are also approved by the relevant partner (DE- DEULA, IT-JAC, HU-iTStudy).

R2-A4: Piloting the course with VET teachers in three countries (DE, IT, HU)

Teachers will be invited to the course during the related multiplier events (E1-E3).

We aim at enrolling at least double the number of teachers than the expected indicators, to make sure we will have at least 25 (5-DE, 5-IT, 15-HU) teachers completing the course successfully.

Mentors will assist participants through the 4 online modules, moderating forum discussions, solving technical issues, grading submitted assignments.

Teachers have to perform above 75% overall in the online part and attend the practical session to complete the course successfully.

The course will be evaluated by the participants, as well as by the project partners.

After the pilot based on the feedback from participants as well as project partners we will review the learning content and amend it and submit the programme for accreditation in Hungary.

In Germany and Italy we will also try to find ways of making the programme available for VET teachers even after the pilot course.
