Description:

The Presentation Event took place during a conference on generational change in VET training, as this was an occasion to reach our target audience of VET trainers and teachers from Region Lombardy.

After a general presentation of the overall project and on the activities foreseen in JAC within VETProfit, Giulia Nembrini presented the VETProfit Course for teachers and training, showing its platform on Moodle. Each of the four modules of the course was briefly presented to the audience, as well as the main learning outcomes for the teachers.

The presentation ended with a Q&A session that gave the teachers and trainers the possibility to understand fully their opportunities within the VETProfit project.



Results of the evaluation

Based on the results of the satisfaction questionnaire, the event was quite successful. The great majority of participants claimed to be satisfied or extremely satisfied with the environment and venue of the event, as well as with the quality of the speakers. Some criticalities emerged regarding the perception of how useful the information given was. This is probably due to the fact that the course was open only to internal staff of JAC, so the external participants to the event did not fully understand how they could use the course in this phase. Nonetheless, over 70% of participants were very satisfied with the event overall.
